



RESEARCH TESTING

- · Nate has universal appeal!
- Big Nate performs strongly among kids' 7-11
- Kids 7-9 are drawn to the comedy and basic premise, while Kids 10-11 appreciate that much of the situational comedy and storylines are geared towards them.
- The variety of humor and relatable characters provides multiple entry points to a broad audience of kids, and KPI scores for kids 7-9 and boys 10-11 are among the highest of the animatics tested!
- Humor plays a significant role in kids' enthusiasm for the show. Favorite funny moments range from slapstick comedy and bathroom humor to irony and one-liners.
- · Nate's wild imagination is one of kid's favorite qualities.


- Kids are drawn to his pranks and mischievous personality, and while he can "cause a lot of trouble" at times, his behavior is acceptable because he has his friend's and the school's best intentions in mind.
- A major theme in Big Nate is the importance of friendship and "having each other's backs." Having friends that believe in Nate and stand by his side helps to validate that Nate has a good side versus just being a troublemaker. Nate's friends, Teddy, Francis, and Dee Dee are all credited for their loyalty and commitment to Nate.
- These characters are so easily knowable and likeable that expanding their worlds to familiar places like their homes will give kids a deeper connection, allowing more opportunity to invest in their stories back at school.








