1 LINCOLN

REVEAL: They lounge on the RV couch. Lincoln and Lana play video games on a TV.

LANA

You said it.

The camera passes Lori in a massage chair.

4 LORI

<VOICE VIBRATING> RV livin' is
literally the life for us. Why are
we stopping?

The RV comes to a stop.

5A MOM

Exciting news! For my next piece in the travel series we are all going to check out the beauty of the Rocky Mountains here in Colorado.

Mom gestures out the window to the gorgeous mountain landscape. The kids looks out.

6 LINCOLN/LOLA/LUNA

Cool./Definitely rocky./Sweet.

The kids close the blinds. Mom reopens them.

7 MOM

No, I meant we're going outside for an invigorating ten mile hike. You guys are going to love it!

8 LINCOLN/LUNA/LOLA

Nah./I'm good./You kids have fun.

9 DAD (O.S.)

Come on, fam.

The kids look up REVEALING Dad in Lincoln's convincing suit. It's way too small for him.

10 LINCOLN

Is that my convincing suit?

11 DAD

<STRUGGLING TO BREATH> Maybe. It'll
be great to get out of the RV for a
while for some fresh air. Your
mother and I made some of our best
memories hiking. And we want that
for all of you! <CHUCKLES>

12 MOM

There's nothing like enjoying what nature has to offer. So what do you say kids?

Mom and Dad smile pleadingly at the kids.

13 LINCOLN

Maybe it's because I've never been on the receiving end of that suit, but I'm convinced. Besides, how bad can hiking be?

EXT. ROCKY MOUNTAINS - WINDING NARROW PATH - DAY

QUICK BEATS as we PAN from kid to kid:

14 LOUD KIDS WALLA

<PANTING/GROANING>

Lori waves her phone around.

17 LORI

There is literally no signal!

Leni and Lily are swarmed by mosquitos. Lily burps at the mosquitos and they fly off in a stink cloud.

15 LENI

<SWATTING EFFORTS> Get away!

15A LILY

<BURPS>

Lynn and Lucy walk past a tree. Lynn obliviously allows a branch to swing back knocking over Lucy <00F!>.

18 LUCY

<00F!>

Lucy folds her arms like a corpse.

19 LUCY (CONT'D)

Leave me here. I belong to the mountains now.

Lola steps over Lucy wearing stylish hiking heels.

20 LOLA

At least I can practice my strut for the Little Miss Rough Terrain Pageant.

Gusts of heat and cold rush past the kids.

24 LINCOLN

<PANT> Too hot. Too cold. Too hot.
Too cold. And now it's hot again.
But hey... we are making lifelong
memories, right?

25 LOLA

<UGH> More like lifelong
nightmares!

26 LYNN

I agree. This hike's a bust.

27 LANA

I bet Mom and Dad are having as rough a time as we are.

Ahead, Mom and Dad blissfully lead the hike, unaware of whats going on behind them.

MOM/DAD

<SIGH!>

28 DAD

I've never felt more alive!

Back on the kids, reacting.

29 LOUD KIDS

<GROAN>

30 LUNA

We're never gonna make it, dudes.

31 LORI

We have to convince Mom and Dad to let us go back to the RV. Lincoln, pull out the convincing suit.

32 LINCOLN

Dad stretched it out. But don't worry, I have a plan! Follow me!

The kids follow Lincoln. Lisa falls in a deep puddle.

33 LISA

<STRAINING EFFORT> Uh, siblings?
Would someone mind lending me a
five-fingered appendage.

Lisa realizes no one is coming back to help her.

LISA (CONT'D)

(sarcastic)

Good to know you can always count on family.

Lisa jumps out of the puddle.

EXT. ROCKY MOUNTAINS - RIVER BANK - DAY

The family walks alongside a river. Seeing Mom and Dad aren't watching, Lincoln gives Lucy a thumbs up.

35 MOM

<WHISTLING AWAY>

Suddenly Lucy takes off her bag and drops it into the river.

36 LUCY

(deadpan/bad acting)
Oops. All of our food has fallen
into the river. Now we will perish.

37 LOLA

Clearly our school's drama department has some work to do.

38 MOM/DAD

<GAH!>

Mom and Dad $\langle \text{GASP} \rangle$ and run alongside the river trying to catch the bag.

38A DAD

Oh no! My home-made grano-lynn bars!

39 MOM/DAD

<RUNNING EFFORTS>

40 MOM

Luan! I think you can reach it!

Luan makes Mr. Coconuts reach weakly, missing the bag.

41 LUAN (AS MR. COCONUTS)

<REACHING EFFORTS>

42 MOM

Luan, just use your human hands--

43 LUAN (AS MR. COCONUTS) Well, too late, toots. Looks like our food is down the river, and we're up a creek!

Mom and Dad keel over <PANTING> as they watch the bag vanish.

44 MOM/DAD

<PANTING>/<COLLAPSING EXHAUSTED>

Lincoln walks up between them, patting their backs.

45 LINCOLN

Aw. Looks like if we don't go back to the RV, we'll starve! Bummer! Alright let's go everybody!

The kids too eagerly pivot and head back the way they came. Dad runs to block their path, stopping them.

46 DAD

No no no! This will just give us the opportunity to live off what nature has to offer. Don't worry kids, the hike continues!

47 SIBLING WALLA

<WEAK CHEER>

EXT. ROCKY MOUNTAINS - HUCKLEBERRY PATCH - DAY

Mom and Dad enthusiastically harvest huckleberries.

48 MOM

Great idea having us forage for our own food, honey. This will make a great addition to my column.

Dad plucks a huckleberry and eats it. A thorn gets stuck in his tongue.

49 DAD

Mmm! Right. Nothing like
huckleberries fresh off the branch!
<GOBBLES BERRIES> Ow, thorn!

Behind them the kids reluctantly pick berries. Lana canonballs into Lisa's basket and berries go flying onto Lola.

49A LANA Canon-berry!

Lola's face is covered with smushed berries.

51A LOLA

Ugh! Lana, you clod! You know red isn't my color!

Lincoln walks up to Lola.

52 LINCOLN

That gives me another idea!

MOMENTS LATER: Mom is bandaging Dad's tongue. Lola walks up to them with red splotches on her face and arms. She shouts dramatically:

53 LOLA

Oh no! I seem to have a bad case of poison oak! <PALTRY COUGH>. Oh cruel world! We must go back to the RV!

Lola falls into Lucy's arms.

54 LOLA (CONT'D)

(whispers to Lucy)

Now that was a performance.

55 **MOM**

Don't worry, honey. I've got this.

Mom zips off, rapidly returning, with a bowl of nasty looking goo. Mom slathers it on Lola's arms and face.

56 LOLA

<FACE SMUSH EFFORTS>

57 **MOM**

Voila! An all-natural cure for poison oak!

58 LOLA

<SNIFF> Ew! What's in this?!

59 MOM

Herbs, spring water, and squirrel excrement!

60 LOLA

<SHRIEK!>

Lola <SHRIEKS!> and starts brushing off the ointment.

61 LOLA (CONT'D)

Huh. What do you know? I'm cured!

62 DAD

Great work, honey! Your mom is awesome. Onward!

Lincoln spots a BEWARE OF MOUNTAIN GOATS sign. He lights up with an idea.

66 LINCOLN

Beware of mountain goats... I have one more idea!

EXT. ROCKY MOUNTAINS - PATH - DAY

The family continues to hike up a wooded path. Mom and Dad are up ahead. They stop to look at a map. Lincoln gives a thumbs up to Lori who is holding Lily.

69A LORI

Mom, Dad! Lily's got a full diaper.

The kids all begin their own versions of pee-pee dances.

72/72A SIBLING WALLA

Me too!/I gotta take a leak!/Pee pee, pee pee!

73 MOM

Of course! Bathroom break, everyone!

The kids spread out. Mom and Dad hear a RUSTLE.

MOM AND DAD'S POV: silhouetted by the sun, the girls form the shape of a giant mountain goat.

75 LYNN

<MONSTROUS ROAR!>

74 MOM/DAD

<STARTLE>

The roar echoes through the mountains. Dad <SHRIEKS!>

76 DAD

<SHRIEK!> It's one of those rocky
mountain goats I've heard about.
They're very aggressive. They've
been known to injure people!

77 MOM

Kids! Everyone come back!

REVEAL: The mountain goat was the kids in disguise using a tent, scarves, and branches. They whip off the disguise.

The kids gather around Mom and Dad.

78 MOM (CONT'D)

We're sorry to say this, but the hike is off. We've had an angry goat sighting. It's just too dangerous for you kids to be out here with those beasts roaming the woods.

79 DAD

Time to get back to the RV, ASAP.

80 LOUD KIDS

<CHEERING!>

Mom and Dad give them a look.

SIBLING WALLA

Uh I mean--/Oh no./Oh this is
terrible!

Mom and Dad hurriedly turn back the way they came. The kids look to one another victoriously. MP

EXT. ROCKY MOUNTAINS PATH - WINDING NARROW PATH - DAY

The family makes their way back down the mountain. Dad leads the way. He turns back towards the family.

82 DAD

<RUNNING EFFORTS> Hurry like your lives depend on it... because they do-- <AH!>

He finds himself face to face with a herd of MOUNTAIN GOATS. Dad <SHRIEKS> and starts backing away towards the family.

DAD (CONT'D)

<OOF!> No one make any sudden
movements.

84 LENI

(to siblings)
OMGosh, our sisters make <u>really</u>
convincing mountain goats.

85 LISA

No, Leni. Shh! It seems Lynn's roar summoned <u>actual</u> mountain goats.

The goats close in on them, BLEATING and stamping.

86 LANA

I'm not quite as familiar with this Rocky Mountain dialect, but I can tell they are not happy.

B7 LUNA

Maybe I can soothe them with a lullaby. You know, Moon Goat to Mountain Goat.

Luna grabs a ukulele. She STRUMS and sings:

LUNA (CONT'D)

Sleep, angry mountain goats, on this mountain hike/ With visions of whatever that goats like./ Just lie down now, and shut your sleepy eyes/ Please let the Loud family stay alive.

The song doesn't work. The goats aggressively chase after the family!

88A LOUD FAMILY

<!HHH4>

91 LUNA

Ah! Tough room.

The family runs back up the path.

93 LOUD FAMILY

<RUNNING EFFORTS> <SCREAMING>

As they pass, a breeze reveals a "DANGER!" sign, covered with skull and crossbones. The goats follow.

EXT. ROCKY MOUNTAINS - DEVIL'S UNDERBITE PATH - CONTINUOUS

The family runs towards a rickety rope bridge stretched over a massive chasm. They come to a screeching halt.

94 LOUD FAMILY

<YELP!>

95 DAD

Okay, careful, follow me!

Dad starts across the bridge. One of the planks breaks and he falls, just barely catching himself.

96 DAD (CONT'D)

<YELLING!>

MOM/SIBLING WALLA

Lynn!/Oh no!/Dad!/Gasp!

He pulls himself up.

97 DAD

<PULLING UP EFFORTS> <PHEW>

98 LORI

Okay, I am literally not crossing that. I'd rather take my chances with the goats.

Just then the goats run closer to the family. The Louds start running towards the bridge. Lori doesn't notice the goats right away but then <SHRIEKS!> She runs too.

99 LORI (CONT'D)

<SHRIEK!> Wait for me!

Lori and the rest of the family struggle across the rickety bridge. They're almost all the way across when the goats starts gnawing on the ropes holding the bridge up.

100 LINCOLN

They're gonna break the bridge!

100A MOM

Run!

101 LOUD FAMILY

<SCREAMING> <RUNNING>

The family tries to move as fast as the can across but--SNAP!

102 LOUD FAMILY (CONT'D)

<SCREAMING> <OOF!>

<SCREAMING> the Louds go swinging into the other side of the
cliff <OOF!> They dangle there, <PANTING> and clinging to the
bridge for dear life.

104 MOM

Okay kids, stay calm. We need to use the bridge as a ladder to get back up--

105 LOLA (O.S.)

Make way! <CLIMBING EFFORTS>

Lola climbs up over her siblings.

106 SIBLING WALLA

Hey!/Ow!/Come on!/Lola!

107 LOLA

Beauty before age!

She passes Mom, holding Lily. Lily gives her the stink eye.

108 LOLA (CONT'D)

And... before you too.

108B LILY

Hey! <PFFT!>

Lola climbs up.

EXT. ROCKY MOUNTAINS - CLEARING - CONTINUOUS

The family pulls themselves up from the bridge to the edge of the cliff. The family collapses <CATCHING THEIR BREATH>.

108A LOUD FAMILY

<PULL EFFORTS>

109 DAD

<PULL EFFORT> <PHEW> See that? The Louds can handle anything mother nature throws at them.

110 LOUD FAMILY

<PANTING>

111 DAD

Now let's see where to go next.

Dad reaches into his pockets but comes up empty.

112 DAD (CONT'D)

Where's the map? Oh. Oh no. No no no no.

Dad rushes back to look over at the bridge/ladder seeing the map perched on a rung.

Dad dangles over the side to reach it when suddenly it blows into the chasm below.

114 DAD (CONT'D) Nooooo!

The goats stand at the other side of the fallen bridge, laughing.

115 MOM

<AH> Great. So we're completely
lost with no food and no way to
call for help.

116 LISA

Ah, yes. Given our circumstances, I'd calculate our chances of survival at uh... 35 percent.

116A DAD

<GASP>

116 Cont'dLISA

Oh, oh wait - forgot to carry the one. Five percent.

Dad faints and falls into Mom's arms.

117 DAD

<SHRIEKS> <FAINTS>

118 MOM

We never should have taken you kids on a hike. We just wanted to make some lifelong memories together.

119 DAD

And now it seems "lifelong" means only a few hours. This is all our fault. <SOBS>

Dad <SOBS>. The kids guiltily hang their heads in shame.

120 LUCY

Actually, Mom and Dad. This is all our fault.

121 LUNA

We didn't want to do a ten mile hike, so we sabotaged it.

122 MOM/DAD

<GASP>/You what?/Kids, how could you?

123 LUAN

We're sorry. LP

(as Coconuts)

You should be!

(to Mom and Dad)

I tried to talk 'em out of it.

Luan glares at him. Mom and Dad frown at the kids.

124 LINCOLN

But don't worry. We got us into this mess, and if we work together we can get us out of it. Right, guys?

125 SIBLING WALLA

<AGREEMENT>

Lisa steps forward, eyeing the sunset.

126 LISA

Well...judging by the sun's position in the sky, and knowing we took an easterly road, the RV must be uh... this way!

Lisa points to a steep cliff.

127 LORI

How are we supposed to get down?

128A DAD

We'll use what nature provides!

CUT TO the family using vines to repel down the cliff.

EXT. ROCKY MOUNTAINS CLIFFSIDE/WATERFALL - MOMENTS LATER

The family lands beside the top of a waterfall. Luan squints and points.

129 LUAN

Ohh! How are we gonna get past these rapids?

O.S. The Louds hear a tree uprooted.

130 LYNN (O.S.) <UPROOTING TREE EFFORT>

REVEAL Lynn holding a hollowed out tree trunk.

131 LYNN (CONT'D)

We'll use what nature provides!

MOMENTS LATER: The family rides the rapids.

132 LOUD FAMILY WALLA

<CHEERING> <YELPING>

EXT. ROCKY MOUNTAINS PATH - RIVER - MOMENTS LATER

Together the Louds ride the rapids of the river.

133 LENI

How are we gonna get past this waterfall?!

Leni points ahead towards a giant waterfall.

134 LUAN

We'll use what nature--

The family rides the waterfall like a log flume.

135 LUAN (AS MR. COCONUTS) (CONT'D)

(yelling)

<AHH!> --nevermiiiiind!

136 LOUD FAMILY

<YELLING!>

The family zooms down the rapids, flying past giant rocks in the water.

137 LINCOLN

Everyone lean left!

Everyone leans left, narrowly missing a rock.

138 LINCOLN (CONT'D)

Lean right!

They all lean right.

141 LINCOLN (CONT'D)

Aim for that beaver dam!

The family rides over the dam like a ramp up into the air.

142 LOUD FAMILY WALLA

<YELPING!>/<WHOA'S!>/<SCREAMS>

They land right by the RV.

143 LOUD FAMILY WALLA (CONT'D) <PHEW!>

144 DAD We made it!

EXT. RV PARKING LOT - EVENING

The family, exhausted, approaches the RV.

145 LYNN/LUAN/LANA

Can you believe when that bridge broke?!/ You've got to be kid-ing me with those mountain goats./I thought we were goners in those rapids!

146 DAD

Okay okay, we get the message.

147 MOM

We'll never take you on another hike again!

The kids look at them puzzled.

148 LORI

What do you mean? We literally loved it!

149 LISA

I concur. Talk about an adrenaline rush!

150 LUNA Nature is rad!

151 LINCOLN

Mom and Dad, can we sleep under the stars tonight?

Mom and Dad well up with tears, moved. They exchange a look, a smile on their faces.

L52 DAD

<AH-HA!> I'll go grab our
mattresses!

Dad opens the RV door and finds the mountain goats inside, eating the furniture. One of the goats spots dad and <HUFFS>. Dad quickly closes the door.
