#343 – “Dread Of The Class”

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1) EXT. LOUD HOUSE – BACKYARD – DAY

We start on a graduation ceremony in the backyard. Luan stands in clown robes at a podium on a stage. Next to her sits Ronnie Anne, the sole graduate. Benny and Lincoln, the only audience members, watch from folding chairs on the lawn.

Lincoln turns to camera and explains that Ronnie Anne has been taking Luan's online pranking master class and today she's graduating! Lincoln says he's so excited his friend's in town, plus Dad catered the event which is always a bonus. He pops a mac and cheese bite in his mouth then gets quiet – the ceremony is starting! Luan hands Ronnie Anne her diploma and Ronnie Anne is elated... then suddenly looks confused as the diploma bursts into a puff of smoke. Luan shouts, "Just kidding!!" Ronnie Anne is shocked – what is going on?! Luan reveals Ronnie Anne hasn't graduated just yet! There is one final test Ronnie Anne must complete. And this test is the hardest. She must prank the master herself, Luan. And it must be before sundown. Ronnie Anne doesn't think that sounds so hard. Luan throws a fart bomb, disappearing into a stinky cloud. 2) INT. LOUD HOUSE – BATHROOM – LATER

Lincoln watches as Ronnie Anne messes with the shower pipes, using a toolbox. Part of Luan's master class involved learning plumbing skills. Lincoln tells her to hurry; he paid off Lola for her "shower slot" but Luan's turn is next and she's due any minute! Ronnie Anne quickly hooks the shower hose to a pot of chili (extra spicy) hidden under the sink and they run out just as Luan exits her room. They dive into Lisa's room and watch the hallway via her security cameras. They wait for Luan to scream as she gets a surprise chili shower but instead Luan comes out, whistling, perfectly clean, and winks at the camera. Lisa (watching the cameras over their shoulder): "Seems there's a twist here." Ronnie Anne and Lincoln look confused until they hear Dad scream from the kitchen. Lisa: "And there it is."

3) INT. KITCHEN – CONTINUOUS

Ronnie Anne and Lincoln run in to find Luan has rerouted the chili shower and now the kitchen sink is spewing the thick, meaty soup at Dad. Dad uses a baking sheet as a shield, "What's happening?!" Lincoln pulls on Ronnie Anne's arm – *Come on. Luan's next stop is in a couple of hours at Dad's restaurant!* They can get there before her and set up a different prank. Ronnie Anne says good idea – they'll try to go subtler. She grabs a backpack to fill it

with supplies. Lincoln's eyes go wide as she loads water balloons, a shovel, Geo in his ball, half the contents of the fridge, some of the chili, etc.

4) INT. LYNN'S TABLE – LATER

Lincoln sits at a table, hiding behind a menu as Ronnie Anne makes the final adjustments to a booth. She army crawls away just before Luan comes in the restaurant. Ronnie Anne: "You're sure she sits there every time?" Lincoln says like clockwork, "She has some dumb pun about it, but I can't remember." Ronnie Anne says good because any minute a semi-truck's airbag will go off under Luan's butt. But when Luan sits down... nothing happens. Lincoln and Ronnie Anne don't understand – why isn't it going off? Luan's strawberry French toast arrives, "something about this booth gives me a sweet tooth!" and she digs in, still seated on the booth. After a while she gets up to go to the bathroom. Lincoln and Ronnie Anne quickly inspect their handiwork – what went wrong?? But as soon as Lincoln touches it, they both blast off into the ceiling. Luan comes out of the bathroom, laughing. She was way ahead of them – that's why she wasn't actually sitting – just hovering! She hasn't sat on anything in years to avoid possible pranks! *Lynn's not the only one in the family with thighs of steel!* Luan demos by squatting in perfect form. She runs out as Lincoln and Ronnie Anne marvel – Luan really does commit. They both fall from the ceiling.

5) EXT. ROYAL WOODS STREET – LATER

Ronnie Anne and Lincoln roll out a giant sheet of clear plastic wrap, stretching it between two trees so it covers a road but is invisible. Lincoln says any minute now Luan should pass through here on her way to a birthday party gig at Tall Timbers park. Sure enough, they see her rolling down the road on her unicycle. But just before Luan hits the clear wrap, she whips out her spring-loaded punching arm and uses it to punch a hole in the wrap and jumps through like Evil Knievel. Luan giggles, "*Clearly* I won't fall for that! Hahaha!" She rides on. Before Lincoln and Ronnie Anne can remove the still taut clear wrap, Flip and Nacho approach from the other way. Flip, fixing his hair in the rear-view mirror, careens down the road, not practicing safe driving. He nails the clear wrap at full speed. It slingshots his truck backwards into a ditch. Flip groans – this better not make him late for his date with Tammy!

6) EXT. TALL TIMBERS PARK – LATER

The sun has dipped in the sky. Ronnie Anne and Lincoln watch Luan performing with Mr. C at a birthday party from a distance. Ronnie Anne brainstorms pranks – exploding cake? Nah, too mean for the birthday kid. Buy a drone and drop a beehive on Luan? Too expensive. Ronnie Anne thinks back to her training and grins – *work with what you've got*. Hmm. Ronnie Anne has an idea but says they'll need to get closer. Ronnie Anne and Lincoln sneak down to the stage. Luan's props are all locked up (of course) but Ronnie Anne picks the lock – that was also part of the course. Once they gain access to Luan's equipment, they take a few bolts out of her stilts. Luan goes to use them for her last act and sure enough, the stilts break apart and Luan goes careening off the stage and lands on the food table, spraying birthday treats all over the guests. **MP**

Ronnie Anne and Lincoln celebrate in front of the party goers (including the angry Mom of the birthday kid) until... the food covered Luan reveals herself to be... Benny in disguise!!

Even Mr. Coconuts was Mrs. Appleblossom in disguise. Benny: "Sorry, Luan promised me half off tuition if I helped! Her pranking class isn't cheap!" Lincoln and Ronnie Anne hear Luan laughing in the distance and turn to see her watching with binoculars, perched on her unicycle. Ronnie Anne looks to the sky and sees the sun is lower. Part of Luan's class was learning to tell time from the sun. Ronnie Anne grabs on Lincoln's sleeve and they run after Luan. They can't let her get away! They're running out of time to prank her! Ronnie Anne grabs a kid's longboard and two helmets, "Can we borrow these? Have a pie!" Lincoln steps on the back. Ronnie Anne expertly rides them through town, chasing Luan, with Lincoln clinging to her backpack, "I can't look! Is this really built for two??" They jump over Flip and Tammy having a picnic on a date, they hop Vanzilla, sliding across the hood (with Mom and kids inside), they burst through shrubbery, etc.

7) EXT. HUNNICUTT FARMS – MOMENTS LATER

Lincoln and Ronnie Anne pull up to Liam's farm, still pursuing Luan. They spot her unicycle parked outside a giant corn maze. They see Liam coming out of the barn, counting money. He apologizes to Lincoln and Ronnie Anne. Luan paid him a heap of money to grow her a cornfield this year; he had no idea what it was for till now. Lincoln gulps – Luan's commitment is truly terrifying. But Ronnie Anne remains determined. They gotta get in there and hit her with a cream pie before it's too late!

8) INT. CORN MAZE – MOMENTS LATER

Ronnie Anne and Lincoln inch their way through the creepy maze, looking for Luan to prank her. Ronnie Anne tells Lincoln to also be on the lookout for trip wires, there are probably defense pranks everywhere! Just then, Lincoln accidentally sets off a manure prank that nails them. Lincoln isn't sure if they should keep going, "Is it really worth it?" but Ronnie Anne is insistent! "We've come so far!" They hear Luan laughing in the maze and her feet scuttling by. They chase after the sound.

9) INT. CORN MAZE CHASE – QUICK CUTS

- They see Luan's silhouette – *there!* Ronnie Anne heaves a cream pie (from her backpack) at Luan... but then we see it's just corn tied together and shaped to look like Luan. Moments later the pie is flung back at them, nailing Lincoln.
- Ronnie Anne and Lincoln split up. Ronnie Anne runs around a corner thinking she's about to encounter Luan but it's Lincoln. Lincoln also thinks it's Luan but it's Ronnie Anne. They pie each other in the face.
- Ronnie Anne throws a water balloon but it nails Virginia with a Luan wig on.

10) INT. CORN MAZE – MOMENTS LATER

The sun has almost set. Ronnie Anne knows she only has minutes left. Suspecting Luan left the maze, they head for an exit. They bounce off the "exit" (a background painted to look like an exit) and suddenly triggered hay bales fall around them, trapping them in a hay cage. Luan comes out from behind stalks of corn and steps on a hay bale, looking down at them in the trap. *Looks like they're too late. Sorry...Guess Ronnie Anne will have to retake the class. It's okay, she must not have been ready...* **LP**

As Luan says this, the hay bale she's standing on starts to rise. Suddenly "Ronnie Anne" takes off a lifelike mask revealing it's really Liam, "I wouldn't be too sure about that." REVEAL the real Ronnie Anne is operating a forklift behind Luan, raising her up. Luan (and Lincoln) look shocked. *What???* Ronnie Anne turns the forklift and presses a button; the forklift drops Luan into a giant mud puddle. Luan rises out of the mud, still in shock. Ronnie Anne hops out of the forklift and triumphantly reveals how she pulled it off.

We flashback to Lincoln heading into the maze ahead of Ronnie Anne who pauses, looking at Liam, getting an idea.

BACK TO SCENE. Luan slow claps. Lincoln and Liam join in. Luan says she can't believe it, but Ronnie Anne actually did it. She outsmarted and pranked her! She'll be the first graduate ever! Luan gets misty-eyed. She's so proud. Ronnie Anne says well, she did learn from the master! *Good thing forklift operation was also part of the course.* Luan beams and pulls out a muddy diploma from her pocket. She hands it to Ronnie Anne and they share a muddy hug. Lincoln and Liam say congratulations, and they'd really like to get out now. Starting to get itchy... THE END.
