Shackleton, convinced me ancestor
to trade up for a better ship.

Haggis points to a sleek, sexy SHIP. Very nice, compared to the Steadfast. Neckbeard is feeling it.

CAPTAIN CHESTBEARD (V.O.)

The shiesty Shackleton swore on his family name that it was a good deal.

Haggis crosses his heart, and both men SPIT in their hands and SHAKE. Neckbeard captains the NEW BOAT away from the dock. We see the ship's name on the back. It reads, "S.S. Sinks-A-Lot."

70 CAPTAIN CHESTBEARD (V.O.) 70 It was NOT a good deal!

The ship instantly SINKS.

EXT. S.S. STEADFAST - PRESENT DAY

CAPTAIN CHESTBEARD (V.O.) 101 Simon says!

Parker and Mitch stand in front of a PARROT on a perch. The name tag under the bird reads "Simon."

PARROT 102
Simon says, hop on one foot.

Parker becomes a foot, stomping on the deck of the ship. Mitch follows suit.

PARROT (CONT'D) 103
Now twirl around.

Mitch twirls around, but not Parker.

PARROT (CONT'D) 104
Squawk! Simon didn't say.

- CATEGORY: RRR OFF!

105 ANGUS (V.O.) 105
Rrrr off!

Chestbeard and Angus come face to face. Chestbeard <GROWLS> first.
