	We find Burt and Parker in a booth.	
12	PARKER So what you're saying here is there's a clear gap between what the science says is necessary and what the people are asking for.	12
	Burt <pops>.</pops>	
13	PARKER Mmmhmm. I can see that. Also, <chuckles>, birds are jerks, am I right?</chuckles>	13

	Parker chows down on some toast - when GORDY'S head pops up from the neighboring booth.

	Ms. Pam points to an old piece of toast stuck on the ceiling	•
31	MS. PAM (O.S.) Will it ever unstuck?	31
	Everyone waits for Burt to answer. Drama. Then <pop>.</pop>

42	ANGUS Yes.	42
43	ROB Can we talk to him, bro?	43
44	ANGUS Ha. Yeah, real funny, guys.	44
	Angus accidentally shuts the door on their fingers.	
45	ROB (O.S.) Oh, bro!	45
46	ANGUS Good one.	46
	Angus walks off.	
47	ANGUS (to himself) Talk to Burt. <chuckles> What a couple of jokesters.</chuckles>	47
	Another <knock> on the door. Annoyed, Angus answers it.</knock>

	Angus finds MRS. SHORT at the door, not Rob and Rod.

70	ANGUS Well, kiddo. If Burt has all the answers to life, and I firmly believe he does, then who are we to keep that gift from others?
71	PARKER 71 We'd be total jerkfaces.
72	ANGUS 72 And jerkfaces we are not.
73	MRS. SHORT (O.S.) 73 Is it my turn?
	A nervous Mrs. Short stands at the door. Russell leads her by the hand to Burt. (This should all feel like we're addressing the Dalai Lama).

95	PARKER Sorry, Brad! (to Angus) Angus, do you think something's wrong with Burt? He's not making people happy anymore.	95
96	ANGUS Well, it's hard to say. I don't have all the answers, kiddo. Not like Burt.	96
	GR4 (Acorn) is next.
