- -- ALL-YOU-CAN-EAT PIZZA: Zeff serves the Wrights pizza. When Zeff's not looking, Vern sloppily piles all the pizza into his pants, as Marge shoves calzones, into her purse and under her dress. Nate and Ellen <CHUCKLE>. Martin looks embarrassed.
- -- STREET: Nate, Ellen, Vern and Marge throw eggs at a passing car. The car stops, and Martin gets out of it. They <GIGGLE> and run away.
