






She loves how weird and creative Ruby is and would never do anything to discourage Ruby from being her fullest self. Dee has a million interests from mountain hiking to jujitsu, and she hosts company like it's an Olympic sport. Dee's loving spirit is demonstrated by her unending support of Stan's accordion rockstar dreams and Ruby's content creation. If it's weird and kind of "out there," Dee is a fan. She loves her daughter Dee and her granddaughter Ruby deeply, but she judges Stan with extreme prejudice. She wants the best for her daughter, but Stan (in her opinion) is closer to mediocre. More tech-savvy than the average granny, Grandma is constantly on her Bluetooth gabbing away to her network of other local grandmas. She's shrewd, critical, and highly suspicious of Earl, but she's still fun — and a force to be reckoned with.



Tweenkle is a popular influencer/video star who lives in Ruby's area. She lives with her step mom and step dad who act more as her assistants than guardians. In her videos she is cute, bubbly, outgoing, and fun. Her videos often revolve around herself and she cares a lot about outward appearances. Off camera she is cruel, manipulative, self obsessed. And would do anything to win. Win what? It doesn't matter. Her goal is to get everyone on Earth to follow her. She will not stop until that happens. Tweenkle is obsessed with followers (she is up to 3 million). She would not spit in your direction is you have under 10,000 followers. 

She always showers them with treats and snacks. Ruby and Zokie go out of their way to help her out. Earl wants in on the "grift" but her cat Peter would very much like to eat Earl. Mrs. Rodriguez can't stand Earl because he steals seeds from her birdfeeder. Every time something exciting happens on her favorite telenovela, El Caballo del Deseo, she throws her TV out the window. This happens at least once a week.

Grace the Starlet

The dramatic ex-starlet who can't let go of her Hollywood heyday. No matter where she is, Grace acts like she's back on a movie set, and can be seen refering to people as "extras" or shouting "LINE!" when she forgets what she was doing. A blunt, judgemental, and arrogant self-identified BBN -- "Buff Black Nerd." Caldwell is a professional game reviewer and tech enthusiast, so he takes all things virtual very seriously. Caldwell always has the newest tech. He doesn't care too much about the outside world or whatever shenanigans Ruby and Zokie get up to, but he tolerates Zokie's presence because his spaceship souped up the apartment complex's wifi to 5G, which is great for Caldwell's streaming and online gaming. Caldwell has a wealth of knowledge on everything tech, but, like Dee, he's interested in Zokie's alien tech. He may or may not train with Grandma Pearl on occasion.

MR. DUONG

A young, gullible, and overworked adjunct poetry professor at Tres Leches University. As one of the newer residents in Pueblo Village, Mr. Duong is more sensitive to Zokie and Ruby's strange shenanigans, but he's adapting. He's basically the spacey version of Robin Williams's character in "Dead Poets Society" with 65% more tears.


